SUBJECT : Minikhana Classes

Following a meeting between the MNSW Minikhana Sports Committee Administrators, the proposed new Committee Members, MNSW Staff and the MNSW President, it was resolved that clarification of the machines that may be used in Minikhana in the 2007 Manual of Motorcycle Sport needs to be completed and distributed to Minikhana Clubs and participants.

The following interpretation of the rules wording with the introduction of the 150cc machines into the 85cc 2-stroke class will be applied in Minikhana as from today's date and should be read in conjunction with the All Disciplines and Minikhana sections of the 2007 Manual of Motorcycle Sports. The Minikhana section and the relevant clarifications below take precedent over the All Discipline section when applied to the specific disciplines.

Rule 12.16.0.5

4 Stroke 150cc Motocross-type machines may compete against 85cc 2-stroke machines in junior and Minikhana competition.

(These machines MUST be designated as "Motocross Type" by the original manufacturer)

Classes and Categories – Minikhana

26.5.1.3 - Competitors shall be graded according to ability into one of the following classes for their age group and machine capacity.

- a) A Grade – **50cc, 65cc, 85cc 2 stroke or 150cc 4 stroke**
- b) B Grade – **50cc, 65cc, 85cc 2 stroke or 150cc 4 stroke**
- c) C Grade – **50cc, 65cc, 85cc 2 stroke or 150cc 4 stroke**
- d) Nipper
- e) Mini Wheel Grade (7 to Under 16)
- f) Junior Combined Big Wheel
85cc **or 150cc 4 stroke** Grade (12 to under 16)
- g) Senior Combined Big Wheel
85cc **or 150cc 4 stroke** Grade
- h) Senior A Big Wheel 85cc **or 150cc 4 stroke** Grade.

NOTE – All reference to 85/100cc or 85cc throughout the Minikhana chapter should now be read as 85cc or 150cc 4 stoke.



Rule 12.16.1

The following machines are permitted to compete in Minikhana events in the 7 to under 13 years **65cc class** subject to correct wheel sizes as listed below:

MANUFACTURER	MODEL
Honda	CRF70, XR70
Kawasaki	KLX110
Suzuki	JR80
Yamaha	PW80, TT-R90

The following machines are permitted to compete in Minikhana events in the 9 to under 16 years **85cc class**, Junior/Senior Combined Big Wheel Classes subject to correct wheel sizes as listed below:

MANUFACTURER	MODEL
Honda	XR100, CRF100, CRF150R
Kawasaki	KE100
Yamaha	TT-R125

Wheel Sizes

All machines participating in Minikhana must comply with the respective class wheel sizes per machines. For the Minikhana discipline, to participate in each class the wheel sizes must be:

CLASS	FRONT	REAR
Mini wheel	14 inch	12 inch
Standard Wheel	17 inch	14 inch
Big Wheel	19 inch	16 inch

These amendments are effective as from today's date and should be implemented in conjunction with the rules outlined in the 'Minikhana' and 'All Disciplines' sections of the 2007 Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
